The Scientific Committee of the Medical Student Forum (MSF2017) invites you to submit abstracts for poster and or/ oral presentation during the upcoming *Gulf*Thoracic Congress 2017. The MSF2017 Forum will once again be held in conjunction with the upcoming *Gulf*Thoracic Congress 2017 which will take place at Grand Hyatt Hotel, Dubai, UAE on 17-18 March 2017.

Abstracts in disciplines related to Thoracic Medicine or Medical Education may be submitted. Already published Abstracts and Pharma-driven research are not acceptable. Your Abstracts will be reviewed by the Medical Student Forum Scientific Committee shortly after the set deadline (31 January 2017).

The Committee will judge all abstracts based on a set criteria, which includes but not limited to: Relevance and Originality, Significance of the Findings, Clarity, and Overall Quality. The authors will be notified accordingly within a week of the set deadline. Those who submitted more than one Abstracts, unless informed otherwise, it means all your abstracts has been accepted.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- 1. Only electronic submissions using the GT2017 Website (www.gulfthoracic.com), will be accepted. Acknowledgement of receipt will be sent immediately via Auto-Reply to the indicated eMail.
- 2. The language of the conference is English.
- 3. Please indicate the name of the presenter/s clearly.
- 4. The Deadline for Abstracts submission is 31 January 2017.

FOR ALL ACCEPTED ABSTRACTS:

- 1. All students' abstracts will be given the opportunity to display their work at the designated Students Abstracts Display Area. A specific time periods will be indicated for you to be available at your poster's site for possible visits by Chairman and members of the Scientific Committee.
- 2. Your abstract will be included at a special edition of the medical students Program Booklet.
- 4. Top ten (10) abstracts will be identified and subsequently will notify authors to be prepared to deliver 10 minutes oral presentation.
- 5. The Medical Student Forum Scientific Committee will select the top/ best three (3) for the best medical student Abstract Award
